

WILDSPITZE 3.770 m

Day Tour / Summer 2026

Up and down ride with the Pitztal-Glacier Train

Every Friday, the Pitztal Mountain Guide Association offers the Wildspitze as a day tour: In the weekly program as a group tour at a special price or as a private tour. The "Pitzexpress" departs at 7 a.m. on this day.

(The same tour is offered on Sunday for the particularly sporty. As there is no early departure, the tour starts at 8.30 am at the glacier railway. The climbers have to be quicker than described...)

Approximate time: 8 hours

Elevation gained: 1.150 Hm

Distance: 16 km round trip

Description: demanding alpine tour in terms of fitness; you should be in a good physical shape;

safe walking on unmarked trails is required; walking with crampons on a glacier is necessary.

You can learn easily how to deal with the crampons during the tour.

Physical condition: Experienced hikers – 400m elevation / hour

Required Equipment: Crampons, harness with one carabiner, hiking poles with snow plates can rent in office € 6,00 per item

Book: in office, email or by telephone

Payment and equipment check at the Mandarfen mountain guide office at least one day before the tour. Payment in cash only.

Limited number of participants in the group.

Included services: Organization and expert advice from our mountain guide office, guided tour, by a state-certified mountain and ski guide.

Prices:

€ 180,00 per person group tour / weekly program, with at least 4 participants

€ 530,00 private-tour for 1 – 2 persons, each additional plus € 50,00.

Tour plan / description:

Meet at 6:40 am by Pitztal glacier express valley station. Please give the mountain guide the voucher. Your harness and suncream should be on and be ready to go with your guide up to 2.841m with the train. From there you start the hike via alpine terrain to the *Mittelbergjoch*. There is a short 100 m descent and then it is time to rope up and traverse over the glacier towards *Wildspitze*. The last 100 m to the summit is over rocks and snow to the mountain cross. You have just hiked the highest mountain in Tirol at 3.770 m!! As the locals say: „Berg Heil“.

Recommended general equipment:

Backpack approx. 25 l, hiking boots, watertight goretex jacket, long pants, fleece jacket, gloves, cap, sunglasses, sunscreen, lunch and minimum 1 l water.
